ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS:

- Superintendent Bergum Thanked the Hankenhoff Family as the new shelter house was dedicated this past weekend.
- Director Barker stated INDOT will be putting in a four way stop at 18th Street and Indiana Ave., they will however be taking the light down at 18th and Grand and making it a two way stop with traffic not stopping on 18th anymore.
- Mayor York stated that the City had no knowledge of the start of work on State Rd 3 from 3 and 38 to 300 S. There had been no timeline given as to a completion date.
- Superintendent Walker stated it is that time of year again for leaves. The leave vacs and leaf pick up will be done on Fridays. Please do not put our trash bags of leaves with your regular trash, you must 1st call the Street Department and let them know to pick up on Fridays. If bagging your leaves they will only pick up ten bags at a time.
- Chief Boatright stated that burning leaves can be done in City limits from now till November 7th only when but in a barrel with a mesh top on it. No open burns will be allowed.

CITIZENS APPEARING BEFORE THE COUNCIL:

- Carrie Barrett- New Castle Mainstreet passed out a paper that listed all the things
 Mainstreet had used the monies given to them by Council. Also stated that WIFI is
 now available downtown and will be having a fiber cutting in the near future. Mrs.
 Barrett has only heard good things about the clock at 1400 Plaza.
- Corey Murphy EDC gave an update on the EDC and stated they are in the process of looking for a location for a new shell building. EDC had a class on workforce and how to keep talented people in this area. Grants for Grads is one thing that we might look at. Beacon Industries has 8 full time employees and will ramp up till 2022. KBK is now up to 25 employees and Foam Rubber Products has our preformed what they had anticipated in the beginning of their move. Councilman Dicken and Corey Murphy have volunteered to mow 1400 Plaza.
- Henry County Councilman Gray thanked the Council and Board of Works for signing the Stellar Interlocal Agreement and added that Nov 4th they will be doing the presentation which is a seven-minute video at the Statehouse.
- Shawn Default-Chamber of Commerce stated Wednesday October 23rd they would be having a session on human resources law for anyone wishing to attend it is from 9am 12pm. October 29th, 6pm at the Public Library we will be holding our Candidates Forum. Those opposed and un-opposed will be in attendance. Also a special thanks to The Board of Works and NCPD for their work in getting Broad Street closed from 11th to 15th for the Christmas Walk on December 5th.
- Robert Dye thanked Superintendent Walker for taking care of an issue for him and also stated a thank you to the New Castle High School Coach for sending a Trojan Flag to his Grandson serving overseas. It has been passed around on facebook that he is flying the flag proudly.
