

ORDINANCE NO. 3524
AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING FEE PROVISIONS OF I.C. 10-13-3-30

WHEREAS, the City of New Castle Police Department from time to time is requested to supply copies of limited criminal histories to third parties; and

WHEREAS, Indiana Code 10-13-3-30 provides a method by which the department may defray their cost of reproducing these requests for inspection; and

WHEREAS, it is the reasonable to impose these costs so that the taxpayers of the City of New Castle do not suffer a loss as a result of these requests.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of New Castle, Indiana, that the City of New Castle Police Department shall collect a three dollar (\$3.00) fee to defray the cost of processing a request for inspection of limited criminal histories and collect a seven dollar (\$7.00) fee to defray the cost of processing a request for release. However, nothing herein shall give the department authority to charge a fee for requests received from the Parent Locator Service of the Child Support Bureau of the Department of Child Services.

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED that it is the intent of the City of New Castle to conform to the provisions of I.C. 10-13-3-30 as they currently exist and are amended. Thus to the extent the fee provisions set forth in said section increase or decrease, said increases or decreases shall automatically be reflected as amendments to this ordinance without further legislative action by this Council. Any provisions of this ordinance that is deemed in conflict with the aforementioned I.C. 10-13-3-30 shall be deemed null and void and all other provisions of this ordinance not in conflict shall remain in full force and effect.

REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SEVERABILITY. Any provision herein contained which is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unlawful or which by operation shall be inapplicable, shall be deemed omitted but the rest and remainder of this ordinance, to the extent feasible, shall remain in full force and effect.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage and publication as provided for by law.
