ordinance no. 3384 an ordinance amending a certain ordinance which establish the salaries for the police department employees to be payable commencing the first pay in January 2004

WHEREAS, this Council passed Ordinance 3364 which established the salaries for Police Department represented employees of the City of New Castle, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW CASTLE that Ordinance Number 3364 be amended:

Section I.

Extra pay for specialized training-proficiency pay:

- A. Increased for all types of specialized training listed therein from \$19.22 bi-weekly to \$22.50 bi-weekly
- B. Clothing allotment will be increased from the budget amount of \$350.00 to \$450.00. Said \$450.00 will be payable on or before December 28th each year.

That all other provisions of Ordinance Number 3364 not hereinabove amended or changed shall remain in full force and effect.

Section III. SEVERABILITY: Any provision herein contained which is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unlawful or which by operation shall be inapplicable, shall be deemed omitted but the rest and remainder of this ordinance, to the extent feasible, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section IV. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage and publication as provided for by law, and shall be retroactive to January 1, 2004.
