DEPARTMENT HEAD REPORTS:

- Chief Schofield requested consideration for probationary time if a prospective hire had all the necessary certifications. Mayor York informed a meeting would need to be held with the Union to amend their current contract.
- O Superintendent Bergum submitted a proposal for Wood Week in the parks to allow citizens, with permission and signed waiver, to get the wood from the damaged trees after the ice storm. After review, Mayor York moved to approve the proposal. Director Barker seconded. Motion carried 3-0
- o Clerk Treasurer York informed Santa's Mailbox was in full swing.
- Administrator Sloan informed the Board that the Election Day extended hours was a success. He also noted Tour of Lights was scheduled for December 16th and 17th with the 18th available if needed.

Attorney Copenhaver requested a 5 minute break prior to a scheduled public hearing regarding an exception to City Code 90.18.

PUBLIC HEARING (Opened: 10:21am - Closed: 10:55am)

Joy Burke, 912 Spring Street, New Castle, presented her request for exception, to City Code 90.18, for permission to keep her emotion support potbellied pig in city limits. In attendance was Building Inspector Melton who presented several violations of City Code regarding rubbish, trash and infestation. Director Linda Bir Conn of the Humane Society who also presented several animal violations for vaccinations of animals. It was noted that the occupancy of this residence was 4 adults, 3 children (ages 16, 12 and 8 months), 2 dogs and 1 cat as well as the potbellied pig.

After questions presented to Ms. Burke by the Board members, Attorney Copenhaver moved to deny the exception and allow Ms. Burke 6 months to relocate the animal on the grounds that it was a 1) it is a residential area, 2) multiple code and animal violations and 3) the animal was acquired well after the ordinance that established this City Code was created. Director Barker seconded. Motion carried 2-1.
