- Updated Council on the ice and snow removal procedures that took place during the recent snow.


CITIZENS APPEARING BEFORE THE COUNCIL:

DEPARTMENT HEAD REPORTS:



Councilman Peckinpaugh moved to adjourn. Council-lady Bertram seconded. Meeting adjourned.


