ORDINANCE NO. 3724

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 74, SCHEDULE I (STOP STREETS) OF THE NEW CASTLE CITY CODE

WHEREAS, it is in the responsibility of the Common Council of the City of New Castle to protect and provide for the public health, safety and welfare; and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined that it would be in the best interests of the public health and safety to eliminate certain stop signs and add a new stop sign; and,

WHEREAS, it is the intent of this Council to make South $9^{\rm th}$ Street a preferential street with no stops between Indiana Avenue on the south and Broad Street on the north; and,

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Common Council to make North 9^{th} Street a preferential street with no stops from Broad Street on the south to New York Avenue on the north.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of New Castle, that Chapter 74, Schedule I of the New Castle City Code shall be amended as follows:

- 1. Removal of intersections from Chapter 74 Schedule I and elimination of stop signs controlling traffic. The following stop signs shall be removed stopping traffic on 9^{th} Street.
 - (a) Street: 9th Street
 Location: south and north approaches to Church Street
 - (b) Street: 9th Street Location: south and north approaches to Vine Street
 - (c) Street: 9th Street Location: south and north approaches to Spring Street
- 2. Addition of intersection to Chapter 74 Schedule I and addition of stop sign controlling traffic. The following intersection shall be added as a stop street to Chapter 74, Schedule I of the New Castle City Code:
 - (a) Street: Church Street Location: east approach to 9th Street


(Attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A" is a map indicating which stop signs are to be removed and which stop sign is to be added.)


3. <u>Penalty</u>: Anyone who violates this ordinance shall be subject to the penalty set forth in Section 70.99 of the New Castle City Code and any violation shall further be reported to the Indiana Bureau of Motor Vehicles for the assessment of points and other penalties that may be applicable pursuant to State law.


REPEALER: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
