This meeting was called to order by Mayor York at 9:31 a.m.

PREVIOUS MINUTES: Mayor York asked if there were any corrections to the previous meeting. Ed made a motion to approve them as presented. Kenny seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

PUBLIC COMMENT: Georgia Marsh of 3519 S. Memorial Drive had previously petitioned the Board to connect to the sewer system. She appeared before the Board to discuss a letter she received informing her she would have to connect to the water system if she connected to sewer system. She contends her well is working, and the cost to connect both utilities would be too much for her to bear. She was informed, in the letter and during this meeting, that connection to the public utilities was required by local and state law. During the discussion Greg P. told the board he could verify a requirement to connect to a public sewer system if it was available, he was unable to find a law requiring connection to a public water system. He was able to verify it in a phone conversation with the Alliance of Indiana Rural Water. Mayor York suggested taking the issue under advisement to investigate, and to explain further the cost and benefits to Ms. Marsh. There is a possibility the tap fee may have been paid at the time of construction. Janice will investigate that possibility, and Mayor York will meet with Ms. Marsh.
