## ORDINANCE NO. 3736

## AN ORDINANCE ELIMINATING BICYCLE LANES AND ADDING A PARKING LANE ON A PORTION OF BUNDY AVENUE

WHEREAS, it is the duty of the Common Council of the City of New Castle to pass laws that protect the public health, safety and welfare of its citizens; and,

WHEREAS, the traffic committee of this council has recommended that certain changes be made to regulations involving bicycles and parking on Bundy Avenue between Webster Avenue on the south and Southern Avenue on the north; and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined by this council that those changes should be adopted.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of New Castle, that the bicycle lanes on the east and west sides of Bundy Avenue between the northern right-of-way of Webster Avenue extended across Bundy Avenue on the south and the southern right-of-way of Southern Avenue extended on the north should be eliminated.

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED by the council that a parking lane of at least eight feet (8')in width be established on the east side of Bundy Avenue between Webster Avenue on the south and Southern Avenue on the north. This will require a shift of the center line on Bundy Avenue so that the traffic lanes are at least eleven feet (11') in width.

THE COUNCIL FURTHER ORDAINS that the appropriate street markings be made to conform to this ordinance. To assist in making those markings, attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A" is a map showing the changes ordained hereinabove.

REPEALER: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**SEVERABILITY:** Any provision herein contained which is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unlawful or which by operation shall be inapplicable, shall be deemed omitted but the rest and remainder of this ordinance, to the extent feasible, shall remain in full force and effect.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage and publication. Its enforcement may occur after the street markings are properly removed as applicable.

This ordinance is being enacted pursuant to the authority given the City of New Castle pursuant to I.C. 9-21-1-2 and 9-21-1-3(7).
