

ORDINANCE NO. **3737**

**AN ORDINANCE REMOVING A TRAFFIC LIGHT
AND ADDING STOP SIGNS**

WHEREAS, it is the duty of the Common Council of the City of New Castle to protect the public health, safety and welfare of its citizens; and,

WHEREAS, the traffic committee of this council has recommended that the stop light located at the intersection of South Main Street and Church Street should be removed and that committee has further recommended that new stop signs be installed controlling the traffic on Church Street at its east and west approaches to South Main Street making South Main Street the preferential street; and,

WHEREAS, this council has determined that the findings of its traffic committee should be adopted.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of New Castle, that the overhead traffic signal on South Main Street at its intersection with Church Street be removed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED that South Main Street should be the preferential street at that intersection and new stop signs should be installed at the east and west approaches of Church Street to that intersection. These stop signs will be installed on the northeast corner and southwest corner of Church Street directing that Church Street traffic stop before crossing South Main Street.

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED that Exhibit "A" attached hereto being a map of that intersection is a true and accurate reflection of the intent of this ordinance. That stop signs should be installed and the overhead traffic signal should be removed in accordance with Exhibit "A".

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of New Castle that one who violates this ordinance shall be subject to the penalties set forth in Section 70.99 of the New Castle City Code and any violation shall further be reported to the Indiana Bureau of Motor Vehicles for the assessment of points and other penalties that may be applicable pursuant to state law.

REPEALER: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SEVERABILITY: Any provision herein contained which is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unlawful or which by operation shall be inapplicable, shall be deemed omitted but the rest and remainder of this ordinance, to the extent feasible, shall remain in full force and effect.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage and publication. Its enforcement may occur after the stop sign referred to above is erected. This ordinance is being enacted pursuant to the authority given the City of New Castle pursuant to I.C. 9-21-1-2 and 9-21-1-3(7).

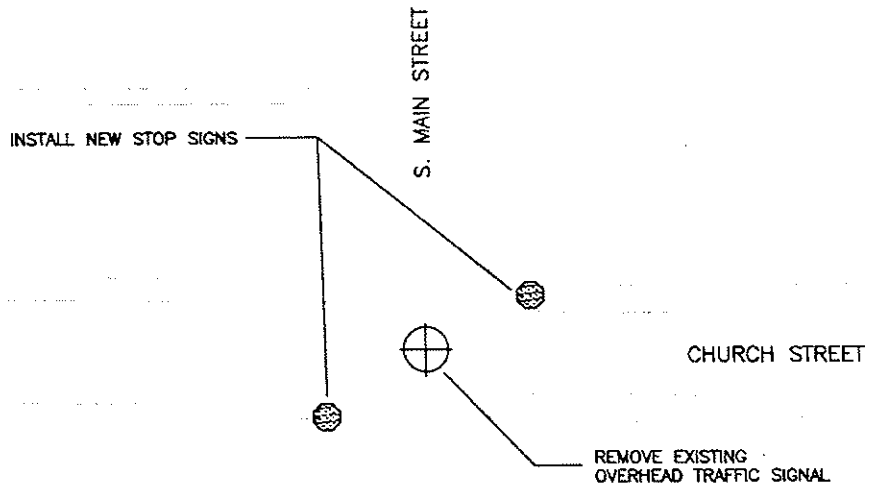
