**NEW BUSINESS:** Betty Milliner came before the Board asking for an adjustment on a water bill on 4322 Judy Avenue. Ms. Milliner indicated she had tried to previously sell the property and now has her daughter living there. From January to March of 2016 she said the service was active, but there was no usage and a minimum bill of \$28.86 was issued for those months. In April, an estimated bill of \$41.14 was issued, and in May a bill of \$91.06 was issued. Service personnel checked the meter and determined it was functioning correctly, but replaced it on May 23<sup>rd</sup> due to the old one was missing a leak indicator. It was explained to Ms. Milliner the city was under the jurisdiction of IURC and was limited on what it could adjust. Mr. Copenhaver made a motion to take the matter under advisement, with Mr. Hill seconding. The motion passed unanimously.

Ms. Burns made a motion to approve an adjustment from June 21 to July 1, 2016 in the amount of -\$1890.00. Mr. Phipps seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
