- Hats off to city workers over the last few months dealing with weather.


ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS:

CITIZENS APPEARING BEFORE THE COUNCIL:


- No citizens appeared before Council.

Councilman Peckinpaugh moved to adjourn. Meeting adjourned.




