

ORDINANCE NO. 3342
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 74 SCHEDULE IV(A) OF THE NEW
CASTLE CITY CODE BY CREATING A NEW ONE-WAY STREET

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the Common Council of the City of New Castle to provide for the public safety, health and welfare of the citizens of the City of New Castle, and

WHEREAS, in carrying out this responsibility, the City has determined that it is in the best interest of said citizens that an existing "two-way" street should become "one-way" street for vehicular traffic purposes,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of New Castle that Chapter 74 Schedule IV(A) of the New Castle City Code shall be changed by designating as a one-way street the following:

STREET:

Erie Avenue

LOCATION:

From 18th Street to Goodwin Street

DIRECTION:

North westerly

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of New Castle that the New Castle Street Department shall immediately upon passage of this ordinance install the appropriate signage to carry out the intent of this ordinance and properly inform the motoring public. Said signage shall conform with the provisions of the Indiana Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

Upon passage of this ordinance, the above street referred to in Chapter 74 Schedule IV(A) of the New Castle City Code shall be deemed to be a one-way street as that term is defined in I.C. 9-21-8-9. Said one-way street is created pursuant to the authority granted this Common Council by I.C. 9-21-1-3(4).

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of New Castle that in addition to the penalties imposed for the violation of posted one-way street designation by the applicable provisions of the Indiana Code, violators of this ordinance may also be subject to penalty and fine pursuant to Sections 71.01 and 70.99 of the New Castle City Code where in the discretion of the arresting officer the application of said code provisions are appropriate.

REPEALER: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SEVERABILITY: Any provision herein contained which is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unlawful or

which by operation shall be inapplicable, shall be deemed omitted but the rest and remainder of this ordinance, to the extent feasible, shall remain in full force and effect.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage and publication as provided for by law.
