

ORDINANCE #3855

AN ORDINANCE RELATED TO TRAFFIC ON GRAND AVE.

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of New Castle may enact regulations related to the travel of vehicles in order to promote and protect the public health, safety, and welfare of citizens of the City of New Castle; and,

WHEREAS, the current speed limit of portions of Grand Ave has been determined to be too low in light of current road and neighborhood conditions; and,

WHEREAS, the Common Council believes that signage should be posted in the area or along Grand Ave. between S. 15th St. and S. 18th St. alerting drivers to the possibility of children playing in the area.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Common Council of the City of New Castle as follows:

1. The speed limit on Grand Ave. from its intersection with S. 15th St. until the corporate limits shall be 30 miles per hour.

2. On Grand Ave., between S. 15th St. and S. 18th St., at least two signs shall be posted directing drivers to the presence of children playing in the area. At least one sign shall be posted facing each direction of traffic.

3. The Street Department shall install appropriate signage to carry out the intent of this Ordinance.

REPEALER: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SEVERABILITY: Any provision herein contained which is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unlawful or which by operation of law shall be inapplicable, shall be deemed omitted but the rest and remainder of this ordinance, to the extent feasible, shall remain in full force and effect.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage and publication as required by law and shall be enforced upon the posting of appropriate signage.
