

RESOLUTION NO. 03182024-1

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE MEMBERSHIP AND TERMS OF THE HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION

WHEREAS, in 2005, the City of New Castle (“City”) established its Historic Preservation Commission, which is charged with overseeing the maintenance, development and improvement of the Downtown Historic District located within the City; and

WHEREAS, City Code and applicable state law provides that an Historic Preservation Commission has seven members, serving staggered terms that are to be appointed by the executive, with approval of the legislative body; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to memorialize the current composition and membership of the Historic Preservation Commission as well as establish definite dates for the end of each members’ term; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of New Castle, Indiana, as follows:
