ORDINANCE NO. 3947

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE COLLECTION OF TRASH AND GARBAGE FROM CERTAIN PROPERTIES OUTSIDE OF THE CITY AND IMPOSING AN ADDITIONAL FEE FOR TRASH AND GARBAGE COLLECTION SERVICE PROVIDED TO PROPERTIES OUTSIDE OF THE CITY

WHEREAS, the City of New Castle has adopted Chapter 95.25 of the City Code authorizing the collection of trash and garbage from citizens residing in the City, subject to specified exclusions and conditions; and,

WHEREAS, the City has implemented a monthly fee paid by eligible customers for the collection of trash and garbage; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to offer trash collection services to persons residing outside of the City, subject to approval of the Street Commissioner and the Utility Impact Review Board; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to establish an additional charge that will be paid by customers that receive trash collection service for a property outside of the City.

NOW THEREFORE BE ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of New Castle, Indiana as follows:

1. Section 95.25 (B) of the City Code shall be amended to include the following:

The City may collect and dispose of trash and garbage from properties outside of the City, subject to the Street Commissioner and Utility Impact Review Board authorizing the collection from each property outside of the City for which collection service has been requested by the owner or authorized occupant of the property. All customers or users of the trash collection service on properties outside of the City shall comply with all applicable Ordinances and rules of the City regarding the collection of trash and garbage.

2. All property owners or users receiving trash and garbage collection services for a property located outside of the City shall pay, in addition to all other then applicable charges for trash collection service, an additional fee of four dollars (\$4.00) per month for each month that trash collection service is provided.

REPEALER: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SEVERABILITY: Any provision herein contained which is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unlawful or which by operation of law shall be inapplicable, shall be

deemed omitted but the rest and remainder of this ordinance, to the extent feasible, shall remain in full force and effect.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage and publication as provided for by law.
