

RESOLUTION NO. 05192025-1

**A RESOLUTION RESCINDING THE PRIOR ALLOCATION OF REVENUE TO
VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENTS AND THE NEW CASTLE FIRE DEPARTMENT
FOR THE YEAR 2026**

WHEREAS, Indiana Code §6-3.6-6-8 (d), permits the adopting body to allocate revenue generated from the local income tax for public safety to a township fire department, volunteer fire department, fire protection territory or fire protection district that provides fire protection or emergency medical services and is operated by or serves a political subdivision; and

WHEREAS, Indiana Code §6-3.6-6-8 (c), permits the adopting body to distribute a specified amount of revenue generated from the local income tax for public safety to a fire department that provides fire protection or emergency medical services within the county that is operated by or serves a political subdivision that is not entitled to receive a distribution of tax revenue from the local income tax for public safety purposes; and

WHEREAS, the adopting body for Henry County is the local income tax council; and

WHEREAS, on July 25, 2024, the local income tax council adopted Resolution 2024-07-25-004 , in which it authorized the distribution of revenue collected from the portion of the local income tax for public safety purposes equal to .05% for the rate to from the local volunteer fire departments : (a) Mooreland Volunteer Fire Department; (b) Spiceland Township Volunteer Fire Department; (c) Straughn Volunteer Fire Department; (d) Stoney Creek Blountsville Volunteer Fire Department; (e) Cadiz Volunteer Fire Department; (f) Kennard Volunteer Fire Department; (g) Jefferson Township Volunteer Fire Department; (h) Knightstown-Wayne Township Volunteer Fire Department; and (i) Greensboro Volunteer Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, on July 25, 2024, the local income tax council adopted Resolution 2024-07-25-005, in which it authorized the distribution in the amount of \$125,000.00 to the New Castle Fire Department from the revenue generated by the local income tax for public safety purposes for service to Henry Township; and

WHEREAS, on February 3, 2025, the local income tax council adopted Resolution 2025-02-03-001, in which it attempted to revised the allocation of revenue from the local income tax for public safety purposes to local volunteer fire departments and the New Castle Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, the local income tax council does not wish the for the distributions authorized for 2025 to be made again in 2026 and wishes to adopt a resolution rescinding the above- described Resolutions for the year 2026.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

The Common Council of the City of New Castle, Indiana hereby casts its 35.56 votes in favor of the Resolution above.
