A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DISTRIBUTION OF REVENUE TO FIRE DEPARTMENTS PURSUANT TO INDIANA CODE § 6-3.6-6-8 (c)

WHEREAS, Indiana Code §6-3.6-6-8 (c), permits the adopting body to distribute a specified amount of revenue generated from the local income tax for public safety to a fire department that provides fire protection or emergency medical services within the county that is operated by or serves a political subdivision that is not entitled to receive a distribution of tax revenue from the local income tax for public safety purposes; and

WHEREAS, the adopting body for Henry County is the local income tax council; and

WHEREAS, on or before July 1, the following fire departments made application for a distribution of a local income tax revenue: (a) Mooreland Volunteer Fire Department; (b) Spiceland Township Volunteer Fire Department; (c) Straughn Volunteer Fire Department; (d) Stoney Creek Blounstville Volunteer Fire Department; (e) Cadiz Volunteer Fire Department; (f) Kennard Volunteer Fire Department; (g) Jefferson Township Volunteer Fire Department; (h) Knightstown-Wayne Township Volunteer Fire Department; (i) Greensboro Volunteer Fire Department; (j) the Prairie Township Volunteer Fire Department; (k) the Shirley Volunteer Fire Department; (l) the Dunreith Volunteer Fire Department; (m) the Middletown Volunteer Fire Department; (n) the New Lisbon Volunteer Fire Department; (o) the Lewisville Volunteer Fire Department; and (p) the Liberty Township Volunteer Fire Department; and (q) the New Castle Fire Department.

WHEREAS, each of the above fire departments serves a township that is not eligible to receive a distribution of tax revenue from the local income tax for public safety purposes.

In accordance with Indiana Code §6-3.6-6-2.8 (c), the local income tax council
