### **COMMITTEE REPORTS:**

- Sandy York requested the pot holes in the area of 27<sup>th</sup> and D Avenue near the old Ferodo Plant be checked and repaired. Also, in the 2800 block of D Avenue there is a street light out and requested it be reported.

- Mary Malone stated that street light reporting can be done through Duke or on-line per the Mayor's Assistant Hill. Mary Malone also noted pothole and manhole issues on Riley Road.
- Vaughn Reid reported an area on 17<sup>th</sup> Street. Mayor York stated the city was aware of this area and has placed it on the paving list instead of patching it. Vaughn Reid also reported the pothole on Vine Street behind the Jail is still an issue.
- Rex Peckinpaugh stated he was pleased to be a part of Hope Initiative's planning recently and commended Lisa Archey for her community efforts.
