

ORDINANCE NUMBER 3386  
AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A LAW ENFORCEMENT FUND  
(NON-REVERTING FUND)

WHEREAS, I.C. 34-24-1-1 provides for the seizure of certain property in certain criminal matters, and

WHEREAS, I.C. 34-24-1-9 provides that any funds received by a local governmental unit as a result of such seizure must be deposited into a non-reverting fund and may be expended only in accordance with the statute after approval by the executive, and

WHEREAS, the City of New Castle may be in a position to receive such seized funds in the future but does not have a Law Enforcement Non-Reverting Fund.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW CASTLE that it hereby establishes a Non-Reverting Law Enforcement Fund for the purpose of receiving allocations from the seizure of certain property forfeited pursuant to statute. Money may be appropriated from said non-reverting fund only pursuant to statute after approval by the executive for needs of law enforcement.

REPEALER: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


SEVERABILITY: Any provision herein contained which is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unlawful or which by operation shall be inapplicable, shall be deemed omitted but the rest and remainder of this ordinance, to the extent feasible, shall remain in full force and effect.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage and publication as provided for by law.

ADOPTED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW CASTLE THIS 6th DAY OF July, 2004.




