## A RESOLUTION OF THE NEW CASTLE COMMON COUNCIL ESTABLISHING THE ROSE CITY BICYCLE/PEDESTRIAN TRAIL AND DESIGNATING THE ROUTE THEREOF

WHEREAS, it is a responsibility of this Council to adopt measures that promote the public health, safety and welfare; and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the establishment of bicycle/pedestrian trails promotes a sense of community, fosters outdoor activities, and improves public safety; and,

WHEREAS, after much study, a trail for pedestrians and bicycles has been recommended to this Common Council; and,

WHEREAS, an appropriate name for this bicycle/pedestrian trail is the "Rose City Trail".

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL that a bicycle/pedestrian trail named the Rose City Trail is hereby established. The route for said trail is fully set out in the description attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "1" and further documented by the map which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "2".

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the City shall properly mark this trail with appropriate signage and street markings so that the trail can easily be identified and followed by pedestrians, bicycle riders, and observed by motorists.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that this Common Council supports the use of this trail and encourages the citizens of the City of New Castle and those visiting the City to utilize the trail for recreational purposes and that said use be consistent with the purposes for which it has been established.

REPEALER: All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict
herewith are hereby repealed.

<u>SEVERABILITY</u>: Any provision herein contained which is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unlawful or which by operation shall be inapplicable, shall be deemed omitted but the rest and remainder of this resolution, to the extent feasible, shall remain in full force and effect.

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** This resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage.

Beginning at the intersection of Cherrywood Avenue and Riley Road, commence north along Cherrywood Avenue to the intersection with S. 14<sup>th</sup> Street, then northwesterly along S. 14<sup>th</sup> Street to the intersection with I Avenue. Continue east along I Avenue to S. 16<sup>th</sup> Street, and then north along S. 16<sup>th</sup> Street to the intersection with D Avenue, then west along D Avenue to the northern leg of S. 16<sup>th</sup> Street, and north along S. 16<sup>th</sup> Street to C Avenue, then west along C Avenue to S. 15<sup>th</sup> Street. Continue north on S. 15<sup>th</sup> Street to the intersection with B Avenue, then west along B Avenue to the northern leg of S. 15<sup>th</sup> Street, and then north along S. 15<sup>th</sup> Street to the intersection with A Avenue, then west along A Avenue to the intersection with the northern leg of S. 15<sup>th</sup> Street. Continue north along S. 15<sup>th</sup> Street to the intersection with Broad Street (S.R. 38), then north along N. 15<sup>th</sup> Street to Thornburg Street. Continue west along Thornburg Street to N. 14<sup>th</sup> Street, then north along N. 14<sup>th</sup> Street to the intersection with N. 16<sup>th</sup> Street (S.R. 103), where it ends.
