

ORDINANCE NO. 3317  
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING  
DOWNTOWN PARKING ORDINANCE NO. 2575,  
ALSO KNOWN AS SECTION 72.50 OF THE  
NEW CASTLE CITY CODE AND CHAPTER 75,  
SCHEDULE 7 OF SAID CODE

WHEREAS, with the construction of the new Henry County Justice Center certain parking changes are necessary, and

WHEREAS, parking signage and lane striping has been accomplished to accommodate said Henry County Justice Center.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL of the New Castle City Code that the New Castle downtown parking area as set forth in Ordinance No. 2575, and as found in the New Castle City Code Chapter 75, Schedule 7 is hereby amended as follows:

A. NEW PARKING ZONE LIMITATIONS

1. The south side of Race Street bounded on the west by 12<sup>th</sup> Street and the east by south Main Street shall have parking limited to one hour intervals only. Further, police parking only spots will be designated accordingly.
2. The east side of 12<sup>th</sup> Street from its intersection with ~~Central Avenue~~ <sup>Race</sup> on the south to Broad Street on the north shall be designated as one-hour parking.
3. The north side of Race Street from 12<sup>th</sup> Street to the west to south Main Street on the east shall be designated as one-hour parking only.

B. ENFORCEMENT

1. These parking zones shall be enforced Monday through Friday from the hours of 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. Violators shall be subject to penalties as set forth in New Castle City Code Section 72.99(A). Further, violators may, at the discretion of the New Castle City Police Department have their vehicles towed and placed in storage. All violators shall be responsible for the costs of towing, storage, and any Court costs incurred in the enforcement of this ordinance. Further, violators of this ordinance are subject to the provisions of New Castle City Code Section 72.99(H).

**REPEALER:** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**SEVERABILITY:** Any provision herein contained which is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unlawful or which by operation shall be inapplicable, shall be deemed omitted but the rest and remainder of this ordinance, to the extent feasible, shall remain in full force and effect.

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage and publication.
