

ORDINANCE NO. 3838

**AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING
THE FIRST AID RECOVERY (EMS) FUND**

WHEREAS, the City has previously established a First Aid Recovery Fund (“EMS Fund”) for the deposit and expenditure of revenue received by the City for providing emergency medical service; and,

WHEREAS, a portion of the revenues for provision of emergency medical services are deposited in the City’s General Fund; and,

WHEREAS, the EMS Fund should be amended to provide that it is a non-reverting fund and that all revenues received from providing emergency medical services shall be deposited into the EMS Fund and utilized for the operation of the City’s Emergency Medical Services Department.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of New Castle, Indiana as follows:

The City EMS Fund (originally established under Ordinance 3416) shall be a non-reverting fund. All revenues received by City for the provision of emergency medical services shall be deposited into the EMS Fund. The sums credited to the EMS Fund shall be utilized for the operation of the City’s Emergency Medical Services Department, including the payment of salaries and wages, insurance, training, and for the acquisition of equipment and supplies.

REPEALER: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SEVERABILITY: Any provision herein contained which is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unlawful or which by operation shall be inapplicable, shall be deemed omitted but the rest and remainder of this ordinance, to the extent feasible, shall remain in full force and effect.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall become effective as of July 20, 2020.
