A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ALLOCATION OF CORONAVIRUS LOCAL FISCAL RECOVERY FUNDS FOR THE PROVISION OF SPECIFIED GOVERNMENT SERVICES AND AMENDING THE CITY'S WRITTEN PLAN FOR EXPENDITURE

WHEREAS, the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 ("ARP"), was enacted on March 11, 2021; and

WHEREAS, ARP, among other things, established a Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund, which provides for the disbursement of revenue from the United States Treasury to local governmental units to assist local governmental units in remedying the negative fiscal impacts stemming from the COVID 19 Public Health Emergency; and

WHEREAS, the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund, established under 42 U.S.C. § 803, provides for distribution of revenue to "non-entitlement units of local government," such as the City of New Castle, Indiana.; and

WHEREAS, revenue received from the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund may only be utilized for the specified purposes set forth in 42 U.S.C. § 803 (c); and

WHEREAS, one of the permitted uses of funds received is "for the provision of government services to the extent of the reduction in revenue of such....non-entitlement unit of local government....due to the COVID-19 public health emergency relative to revenues collected in the most recent full fiscal year of the.... non-entitlement unit of local government....prior to the emergency; or"; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Treasury has adopted a Final Rule regarding the calculation of reduction of revenue that provides that a recipient can utilize funds to replace lost revenue up to the amount of actual loss calculated or can elect a standard allowance for revenue loss of up to Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000) over the period of performance; and

WHEREAS, the provision of government services, as defined in the Final Rule, is any service typically performed by a government, including, the construction of infrastructure and the provision of emergency services; and

WHEREAS, the City of New Castle wishes to elect to utilize the standard allowance for revenue loss and to allocate revenue received from the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund, as described in this Resolution to the General Fund and to appropriate those amounts for repair and improvement to the sidewalks near the Babe Ruth baseball diamond and for the renovation of a building for use as a station for the City's Police Department;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Common Council of the City of New Castle, Indiana, as follows:

- 1. The Common Council hereby allocates the sum of up to Four Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$430,000.00) to the City General Fund as replacement of revenue lost due to the COVID-19 public health emergency.
- 2. The City of New Castle elects to utilize the standard allowance of up to Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000.00) for the purpose of calculating revenue loss for purposes of 42 U.S.C. § 803 (c) (1) (C).

WRITTEN PLAN FOR EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS RECEIVED FROM THE CORONAVIRUS LOCAL RECOVERY FUND

The City of New Castle shall expend revenue received from the Coronavirus Local Recovery Fund as follows:

- 1. To provide premium pay to eligible workers employed by the City as described in Ordinance 3877.
- 2. The sum of up to One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) to acquire body worn cameras, software and related equipment for use by the Police Department.
- 3. The sum of up to Four Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$430,000.00) as replacement of revenue lost due to the COVID-19 public health emergency for the provision of the specific government services below:
- a. The sum of up to Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$80,000.00) for the construction and repair of the sidewalk adjacent to the Babe Ruth baseball diamond; and
- b. The sum of up to Three Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$350,000.00) for the completion of construction of a station for use by the City's Police Department.
