RESOLUTION NO. <u>06202023-1</u>

A RESOLUTION APPROVING ACQUISTION OF POLICE VEHICLES THROUGH LEASING FINANCING

WHEREAS, the City of New Castle wishes to acquire ten (10) new vehicles for use by its Police Department and to acquire equipment and striping for the vehicles; and,

WHEREAS, the City wishes to utilize a lease-finance purchase arrangement under which the City will be required to make lease payments and at the end of the lease term will acquire ownership of the vehicles; and,

WHEREAS, the City has solicited quotes from multiple financial institutions in an effort to determine the most advantageous interest rate in connection with a lease-finance purchase transaction; and,

WHEREAS, Citizens State Bank of New Castle has offered the lower annual interest rate for the lease-finance purchase of vehicles; and,

WHEREAS, the City wishes to enter into a lease-finance purchase transaction with Citizens State Bank (or an affiliate institution) to acquire vehicles.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of City of New Castle, Indiana, as follows:

- 1. The City may enter into a six (5) year lease finance purchase transaction with Citizens State Bank, acting directly or indirectly through another financial institution, for the acquisition of the vehicles and related equipment and improvements to vehicles.
- 2. The total amount that may be financed for the acquisition of the vehicles and related equipment shall not exceed four hundred forty-seven thousand six hundred forty-one dollars (\$447,641.00), over a lease term of no more than (5) years with an interest rate of 5.00% per annum.
- 3. The Common Council will budget sufficient amounts from LIT in future years to make the payment required under the lease.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.

<u>REPEALER</u>: All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SEVERABILITY: Any provision herein contained which is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unlawful or which by operation of law shall be inapplicable, shall be deemed omitted but the rest and remainder of this resolution, to the extent feasible, shall remain in full force and effect.
