ORDINANCE NO. 3458

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 75, SCHEDULE 1 OF THE NEW CASTLE CITY CODE ENTITLED, "NO PARKING ZONES"

WHEREAS, it has been determined that a new location should be added as a "no Parking zone" to Chapter 75, Schedule 1 of the New Castle City Code;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of New Castle that the following location shall be added to Schedule 1, Chapter 75 of the New Castle City Code and shall be made designated as a "no parking/tow in zone".

<u>Street</u> <u>Side</u> <u>Location</u>

Woodward Avenue South

commencing on the west at the intersection of Woodward Avenue and $14^{\rm th}$ Street and proceeding east to the intersection of Woodward Avenue and $16^{\rm th}$ Street

PENALTY

The penalty for violation of this ordinance shall be as follows:

"Whoever violates this ordinance shall have their vehicle towed and impounded as provided for in New Castle City Code Sections 72.40 and 72.41 and be fined according to the following:

- (a) shall be assessed a fine of not less than \$50.00 or more than \$250.00;
- (b) This ordinance incorporates herein by reference the provisions of Section 72.99 (A), which provides that a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day that a violation occurs or continues, and Section 72.99 (D) which provides that a violator of this ordinance shall be responsible for the costs incurred in towing the improperly parked vehicle and storage thereof. The violator shall also be responsible for costs incurred in prosecuting the action for improper parking which shall include, but not be limited to, court costs."
- (c) Failure to pay a citation issued hereunder imposes the provisions of New Castle City code Section 72.99(H).

This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage of publication.

REPEALER: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SEVERABILITY: Any provision herein contained which is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unlawful or which by operation shall be inapplicable, shall be deemed omitted but the
