

**A RESOLUTION OF THE NEW CASTLE COMMON COUNCIL APPROVING
AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE
TOWN OF SULPHUR SPRINGS

WHEREAS, the City of New Castle has been contacted by representatives of the Town of Sulphur Springs seeking an Interlocal Agreement between the Town of Sulphur Springs and the City of New Castle for the enforcement of their Town ordinances regarding fees and fines; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the citizens of Henry County generally that local communities cooperate and share resources whenever possible and thus it is in the best interest of the City and Town that the proposed Interlocal Agreement be approved.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF NEW CASTLE, INDIANA that the City enter into the proposed Interlocal Agreement with the Town of Sulphur Springs.

This resolution shall be in force and effect from and after its adoption by the legislative bodies of the City of New Castle and Town of Sulphur Springs.

REPEALER: All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SEVERABILITY: Any provision herein contained which is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unlawful or which by operation shall be inapplicable, shall be deemed omitted but the rest and remainder of this resolution, to the extent feasible, shall remain in full force and effect.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage.
