ORDINANCE NO. 3514 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING NEW CASTLE CITY CODE CHAPTER 74 BY CREATING A NEW FOUR-WAY STOP

WHEREAS, the intersection of South $12^{\rm th}$ Street and Crescent Drive is currently controlled by stop signs on South $12^{\rm th}$ Street at its east and west approaches to Crescent Drive; and,

WHEREAS, it has been determine that it is in the best interest of public safety that Crescent Drive also be controlled by stop signs at the north and south approaches to South $12^{\rm th}$ Street,

1. <u>Designation of Stop Street</u>.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW CASTLE that Chapter 74 Schedule 1 of the New Castle City Code is hereby amended by adding to those streets where a stop sign should be located the following street:

STREET

LOCATION

Crescent Drive

north and south approaches to South 12^{th} Street

By adding these stop signs to the intersection of Crescent Drive and South $12^{\rm th}$ Street, said intersection becomes a four-way stop with stop signs controlling all approaches to the intersection.

2. <u>Penalty</u>.

One who violates this ordinance shall be subject to the penalties set forth in Section 70.99 of the New Castle City Code and any violation shall be further reported to the Indiana Bureau of Motor Vehicles for the assessment of points and other penalties that may be applicable pursuant to State law.

3. <u>Effective Date</u>.

This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage and publication. Its enforcement may occur after the stop signs referred to above are properly erected pursuant to the provisions of Indiana's Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for streets and highways.

This ordinance is being enacted pursuant to the authority given the City of New Castle pursuant to I.C. 9-21-1-2 and 9-21-1-3 (a) (7).

REPEALER: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SEVERABILITY: Any provision herein contained which is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unlawful or which by operation shall be inapplicable, shall be deemed omitted but the rest and remainder of this ordinance, to the extent feasible, shall remain in full force and effect.
