ORDINANCE NO. 3311 AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF NEW CASTLE, HENRY COUNTY, INDIANA

This ordinance of the City of New Castle, Henry County, Indiana, is an ordinance to annex certain real estate into its corporate boundaries. It is passed and adopted on the month and year hereinafter stated:

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the City of New Castle seeking the annexation of certain territory to said City of New Castle, Henry County, Indiana, and;

WHEREAS, said petition is signed by one hundred percent (100%) of the owners of said territory, and;

WHEREAS, said territory is located outside of, but contiguous to, this municipality, and;

WHEREAS, the owner has indicated a desire to develop said property and in so doing, comply with the laws, rules and regulations of the City of New Castle regarding development.

Section 1: ANNEXATION. NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW CASTLE, HENRY COUNTY, INDIANA, that the following described real estate shall be annexed into the City of New Castle and shall be a part of said City of New Castle, all pursuant to I.C.36-4-3-5.1. Said real estate being annexed by this ordinance is located in Henry County, Indiana, is contiguous to the current boundaries of the City of New Castle, Henry County, Indiana, and is more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

A PART OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER AND PART OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 10, TOWNSHIP 17 NORTH, RANGE 10 EAST, DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

BEGINNING AT AN EXISTING P.K. NAIL ON THE NORTH LINE OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 10, TOWNSHIP 17 NORTH, RANGE 10 EAST, SAID POINT BEING SOUTH 89 DEGREES 58 MINUTES 36 SECONDS EAST (ASSUMED BEARING) 72.60 FEET FROM THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SAID QUARTER-QUARTER SECTION; THENCE CONTINUING SOUTH 89 DEGREES 58 MINUTES 36 SECONDS EAST ALONG THE NORTH LINE OF THE SAID QUARTER SECTION A DISTANCE OF 1,724.00 FEET TO A MAGNETIC NAIL (SET) ON THE WEST RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF THE FORMER C.C.C. & ST. LOUIS RAILROAD; THENCE SOUTH 00 DEGREE 05 MINUTES 23 SECONDS WEST ALONG THE WEST RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF SAID RAILROAD A DISTANCE OF 1,067.37 FEET TO AN EXISTING IRON ROD; THENCE NORTH 89 DEGREES 54 MINUTES 55 SECONDS WEST A DISTANCE OF 706.21 FEET (706.60 FEET DEED DISTANCE) TO AN EXISTING IRON ROD ON THE EASTERLY RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF THE I. N. C. & E. TRACTION COMPANY LINE; THENCE NORTH 43 DEGREES 36 MINUTES 00 SECOND WEST ALONG THE EASTERLY RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF SAID TRACTION LINE A DISTANCE OF 1,473.45 FEET (1,473.65 FEET DEED DISTANCE) TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING.

BEING A PART OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER AND PART OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF THE

NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 10, TOWNSHIP 17 NORTH, RANGE 10 EAST, AND CONTAINING 29.759 ACRES, MORE OR LESS. SUBJECT TO LEGAL RIGHTS-OF-WAY.

Section 2: <u>WARD</u>. The annexed territory is hereby assigned to the following municipal legislative district: Ward 2.

Section 3: CURRENT CORPORATE BOUNDARIES. The current definition of the corporate boundaries of the corporate boundaries of the City of New Castle is set forth in Exhibit "A" being a map of said boundaries and Exhibit "B" being a written legal description. Said Exhibits "A" and "B" are attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section 4: PUBLICATION. Upon passage of this ordinance it shall be published pursuant to the manner prescribed in I.C.36-4-3-7.

Section 5: <u>FILING AND RECORDING</u>. After publication and expiration of the remonstrance period, the Clerk-Treasurer of the City of New Castle shall file and record this ordinance pursuant to the provisions of I.C.36-4-3-22.

Section 6: REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 7: <u>SEVERABILITY</u>: Any provision herein contained which is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be deemed to be unlawful or which by operation of law shall be inapplicable, shall be deemed omitted but the rest and remainder of this ordinance, to the extent feasible, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 8: **EFFECTIVE DATE**: This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage and publication as provided for by law.
