

**ORDINANCE NUMBER 3424**  
**AN ORDINANCE INCREASING THE RESIDENTIAL METER DEPOSIT**  
**FOR NON-HOMEOWNERS**

WHEREAS, Section 51.25(I) of the New Castle City Code establishes the amount charged to customers as a meter deposit for water service, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that there is a need to increase this deposit for non-property owning residential meters (tenants).

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW CASTLE that Section 51.25(I) of the New Castle City Code shall be amended by adding the following additional category requiring meter deposit:

<u>Meter</u>	<u>Deposit:</u>
Residential Meter, Service in name of Property Owner	\$50.00  (No change from current provision)
Residential Meter, Service in name of Tenant or Non-Property Owner	\$100.00  (New category and new charge)

**REPEALER:** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**SEVERABILITY:** Any provision herein contained which is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unlawful or which by operation shall be inapplicable, shall be deemed omitted but the rest and remainder of this ordinance, to the extent feasible, shall remain in full force and effect.

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage and publication as provided for by law.
