

ORDINANCE NO. 3826
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE SCHEDULE OF FEES
FOR THE COLLECTION OF SOLID WASTE

WHEREAS, on June 7, 2010, the city of New Castle adopted an Ordinance establishing responsibilities for trash collection and imposing fees for the collection of trash and garbage; and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the current fees are no longer sufficient to reasonably cover the costs incurred in providing this service, including providing for the replacement of trash containers (“toters”) and the purchase of replacement parts for the containers.

NOW THEREFORE BE ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of New Castle, Indiana that the monthly fee for the weekly collection of trash and garbage, set forth in §95.30(C)(1) of the City Code, shall be increased by the sum of two dollars and fifty cents (\$2.50) per month. The increased fee shall become effective the first month after the passage of this Ordinance. After passage of this Ordinance, the monthly fee set forth in §95.30(C)(1) of the City Code shall be fourteen dollars and fifty cents (\$14.50).

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED that any provision of Chapter 95 of the City Code that is not amended or modified by this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

REPEALER: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SEVERABILITY: Any provision herein contained which is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unlawful or which by operation of law shall be inapplicable, shall be deemed omitted but the rest and remainder of this ordinance, to the extent feasible, shall remain in full force and effect.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage and publication as provided for by law.
