
ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS:

He went into the burning building to drive out the new roller we just purchased. Mayor York, with his own money, flew to San Antonio Texas to look at new trash trucks and had them delivered to our doorstep the following Monday.
- Superintendent Walker also thanked the City of Muncie for sending us man power and trucks to keep the operation running.
- Mayor York stated the City just keeps getting hit. Not only was there a fire in the Street Department, but some of the pumps got hit by lightning at the Sewage Plant. The City has also had 2 employees test positive for Covid.

- Mayor York asked Council if they wanted to move the next meeting back to Council Chambers or would they want to keep them at the Armory for social distancing. Council was in agreement to stay at the Armory as a safety precaution for everyone.


